Redoubt Bay Lodge

Redoubt Bay Lodge is a remote fly-in lodge that sits on the only privately owned land nestled within a 171,000 acres of critical habitat area. It overlooks the picturesque Big River Lakes that teems with fish and wildlife. To the west of the lodge, you'll find the dramatic Chigmit Mountains and the entrance to Lake Clark Pass and Wolverine Creek—offering some of the most prolific bear viewing in the state.

Redoubt Bay Lodge's three overnight, Alaskan-style guest cabins surround the dining lodge where guests gather to socialize with other guests, meet the guides, take meals, and recreate. New for 2014, is the 1200 square foot day-lodge, large deck and bar area for guests to enjoy different views from the lodge property. At Redoubt Bay Lodge, the emphasis is on viewing wildlife and exploring the lake areas and their tributaries surrounding the lodge. The main lodge is an historic hunting cabin that has been converted into our dining area. Our chefs prepare all meals at the dining lodge. There is a small gift shop in the lodge, where you can access wi-fi and find an Alaskan library to peruse. On the grounds outside, you might enjoy sitting by the evening bonfire overlooking the lake, exploring our small herb gardens, or sitting on the deck of your cabin drinking a glass of our variety of wines.

Redoubt Bay Lodge is surrounded by the spectacular natural setting of the Chigmit Mountains. The atmosphere at Redoubt Bay Lodge is pleasantly casual and "outdoorsy". Our rustic setting is best suited for those who wish to explore our unique and wild setting.

What We Do at Redoubt Bay Lodge

After a panoramic 50-minute flight across the Cook Inlet from Anchorage by floatplane, guests land upon the expansive Big River Lake and taxi to the lodge dock. Daily activities include a tour of the lake with a good chance to see bears, kayak and canoe expeditions, and special seasonal activities such as berry picking. Guests can make arrangements with their guide to go sportfishing as the Big River Lakes area is some of the best salmon fishing in the region.

The emphasis at Redoubt Bay Lodge during the summer months is on the spectacular natural terrain surrounding the lodge, the local wildlife residents, and what we can learn from this fragile and memorable environment. Because of the salmon population at Big River Lakes, there are many bears that feed in the local area. A trained naturalist guide will take guests for an up-close and safe view of our nearest neighbors. We are constantly exploring our "neighborhood" for new fishing waters and angling adventures to offer our guests. We can arrange a fly-out to nearby fishing areas. We offer optional packages via helicopter and floatplane. One of the guests favorites is hiking in areas only accessible by helicopter.




